

The following are statements that were answered by teachers, parents, and students as a component to our school profile. Our school profile is being updated and includes information concerning demographics, student achievement testing, the ACRE Test of Religious Knowledge and an update concerning the history of our school. The intent of the survey is to confirm that the teachers, parents, and students have the same perception of the school. The statements that follow were chosen by our Steering Committee because they were statements that were found on all three surveys and could thus be compared. Not all of the responses total 100% since some categories were combined. For example, on the survey strongly agree and agree were two separate responses. On this report they were combined into one. Students in grades 3-4 did not have all the same questions as those in grades 5 – 8.
